Description: The Child Care Law Center is a legal services support center. We work on legal issues that affect low-income families throughout California including state child care subsidies, inclusion of children with disabilities, and licensing. The Child Care Law Center provides materials on its website to help parents and child care providers understand their rights and responsibilities. We are now looking for students to help write or update our Question & Answer publications. The work requires some legal research and writing for a non-lawyer audience. If you are interested in public interest work this can be a great opportunity to write a community education piece which allows you to use take all the legalese you've been learning and translate it into clear, understandable English. The Child Care Law Center also has a legal information service. Interns may also assist in preparing legal information for clients and referring clients to the appropriate resources.

Depending on your availability, you can either update an existing Q & A or draft a new one. Updating a Q & A should take between 10 and 20 hours total and writing a new one will take between 20 and 35 hours. We ask that students commit to finishing a Q & A once starting. The number of hours spent on the legal information service can vary. We can tailor deadlines to meet your needs, but would prefer to have work completed by the end of the semester.
